Physical examination and diagnosis presented by Judy Smyth.

Judy Smyth has been teaching this subject at Endeavour College to all Naturopathic, Homeopathic, Acupuncture, Nutrition and Myotherapy students for over four years. She will be looking at the Vital Signs i.e. Pulse, Respirations, Temperature and most importantly the Blood Pressure in detail. The causes of hypertension/ hypotension and the treatment for both, Homeopathic and orthodox. In the second half she will be looking at the Structures of the Neck such as the Parotid glands, Sinuses, Arteries, Lymph glands - The Lymphatic system and the tonsils. Lastly there will be examination of the ear and Thyroid Gland. **There will be a practical aspect to this presentation so if you have a stethoscope, sphygmomanometer or an otoscope please bring them along.**
